



Education Committee

The Education Committee is responsible for oversight of all educational products and services of NAHCR and implementation of specific programs. The charges to this committee are:

1. Assess the CEU and overall educational needs of our members, outline a plan for meeting these needs and communicate the many opportunities for CEUs to the membership.
2. Provide ongoing evaluation of all NAHCR educational products and services to ensure NAHCR's education programs grow and develop core skills as well as provide specialized content to meet member needs
3. Assess the educational needs of external target audiences and make recommendations to address these needs
4. Administer all educational programming that falls under the responsibility of the Education Committee (IMAGE, Webinar series, CHCR)
5. Solicit educational content from chapters related to trends in health care recruitment for all educational offerings for the membership and/or outside groups
6. Evaluate success of all educational programming and make any recommendations for changes to this programming within the context of the overall education plan
7. Oversee and evaluate the IMAGE program content and structure and make recommendations for any amendments to the schedule to be made in 2016 or beyond.
8. Recommend topics for development of new educational content by Committees or other groups based on 2014 publication review recommendations.

Composition:

The committee will have a chair and a co-chair that serves as the Board Liaison. Additionally, the committee should include a minimum of one CHCR, one PHR (or SPHR), one registered nurse and at least one institutional member. Of these 6 individuals, at least one will serve as the IMAGE Conference Committee chair or co-chair and one of these individuals should have responsibility for coordinating webinars.
